

14 September 1948 Khwaja Nazimuddin made governor general and Liaquat Ali Khan as Prime

Minister

12 march 1949 Objective resolution passed

1949 The Public and Representative (Disqualification) Act [PRODA]

January 1951 Sir Douglas Gracey (british Commander in chief of pak army) was replaced by General

Ayub Khan

October 1951 Ghulam Muhammed sworn in as Governal General of Pakistan

1952 Report of the Basic Principles committee was presented by the Prime Minister Nazimuddin

1953:-

1. Planning Board was setup to review the development that had taken place
2. Feb, food shortages led to rioting in most cities in Pakistan
3. Demand of cotton and jute during Korean War but demand declined by this year
4. 17 April, Nazimuddin dismissed from premiership, Muhammed Ali Bogra appointed Prime minister, First five year plan for economy introduced

1954 24 September Ghulam Muhammed dissolves the Assembly New cabinet sworn

February 1955 Sindh High Court rules that dissolution of Assembly was unconstitutional

10th may 1955 Federal Court overturns Sindh High Court ruling. New Assembly Elected

August 1955 Ghulam Muhammed resigns

5 October 1955:-

1. One unit system introduced
2. West Pakistan to be treated as one unit, not four provinces

March 1956 23 Cinstitution Announced

12th September 1956:-

1. Chaudry Muhammed Ali resigns
2. Hussein Shaheed Suhrawardy made Prime Minister

October 1957 8 Suhrawardy dismissed, I.I, Chundrigar appointed Prime Minister

October 1958:-

1. 7 Mirza proclaimed martial law. Made himself president
2. Ayub Khan made Prime Minister
3. 27 General Ayub Khan take over

October 1959 Baic democracies introduced

February 1960 17 February confirmed as President

1962:-

1. 8 june new national assembly met for the first times
2. Oil refinery established in karachi

March 1962 1 New constitution

1964 economic reunion was formed with iran and turkey, the Regional Cooperation for Development (RCD)

January 1965 elections were held for Presidency

September 1965 War with India

1967 Islamabad was made officially the capital

October 1968 Student protest all over the West Pakistan

February 1969 17 Ayub Khan withdrew the emergency powers and realeased many political prisoners arrested previous october.

25th March 1969 Ayub forced to resign
