

-8 Khilafat Movement-

1914 = WWI start

1918 = Concern about British policy towards Muslim

= End of WWI

1919 = November, Conference at Delhi, to keep promise to keep Turkey safe, 1st Khilafat Conference.

= Treaty of Versailles. 28 June.

= December, Amritsar, 2nd Khilafat Conference

1920 = January, Khilafat Movement called Victory to treat Turkey fairly.

= February, delegation to England to persuade Western Powers, Treat Turkey nicely.

= 22nd June, Non-cooperation if Treaty of Sevres imposed to Turkey. Start 1 August

= August, Treaty of Favour.

(1923 = Treaty of Lausanne.)

1921 = Prince of Wales visited Bombay, nationwide strike. 53 killed

= End, there 30,000 political prisoners in India's jail.

1920 = August, 18,000 Muslim to Hiyat to Afghanistan.

1921 = 8 July, Khilafat movement for 3rd time

= Khilafat leaders arrested.

= August, Uprising by Moplahs in South India

1922 = February, Chauri Chaura incident
= Sultan (Turkey) deprived of political
power = Called of Non-Coop By Gandhi

1920 = Non-cooperation ; Communal rioting
