1927 = Simon Commission arrives in India
= December, Madras session Congress
boycott Commission

1928 = May, All-Party Conference.
= September, 'Nehru report' approved.

1929 = January, 21, All India Muslim Conference
rejected the report.

= January, AIML met in Delhi (Conference)
where Jinnah's fourteen points were introduced
= March, points accepted.

= December, Congress met at Lahore, Jawaharlal
Nehru rejected dominion status.

= 31, December, midnight raised Indian flag

1930 = 12, March, Salt March

= Allahbad Address

= 2 volume report by Simon Commission

= November, London, First Round Table

1931 = February, Gandhi met Lord Irwin

= 5, March, 'Gandhi Irwin' pact was signed.

= September - December, London, 2nd Round Table.

1932 = 16, August, Communal Awards.

= January, Congress restarted Non-cooperation.

= November, 3rd Round Table.

1933 = Four page "Now or Never" by Rahmat Ali

= March, British announced how India should be governed.

1934 = Bill, Introduced to British parliament

1935 = August, Government of India Act.

1937 = January - February elections.

1934 = Jinnah permanent president of the Muslim League.

1939 = British war with Germany, September, 3

= 22, December, Day of Deliverance.

1937 = October, Lucknow meeting of Muslim League

1938 = chief ministers of Assam, Bengal & Punjab joined AIML.
